Summary

DFW recorded a **net gain of 3,300 jobs** in July, bringing the region **45,100 jobs short of February 2020** pre-pandemic levels. From the previous month, **employment** saw little change and the **unemployment rates** in DFW, Texas, and nationwide all **decreased to 5.3%, 6.0% and 5.7%**, respectively. The top three positions posted were once again **software developers, registered nurses, and heavy truck drivers** – all of which saw an **increase in postings** from June.

Some findings when comparing July 2021 and July 2020:

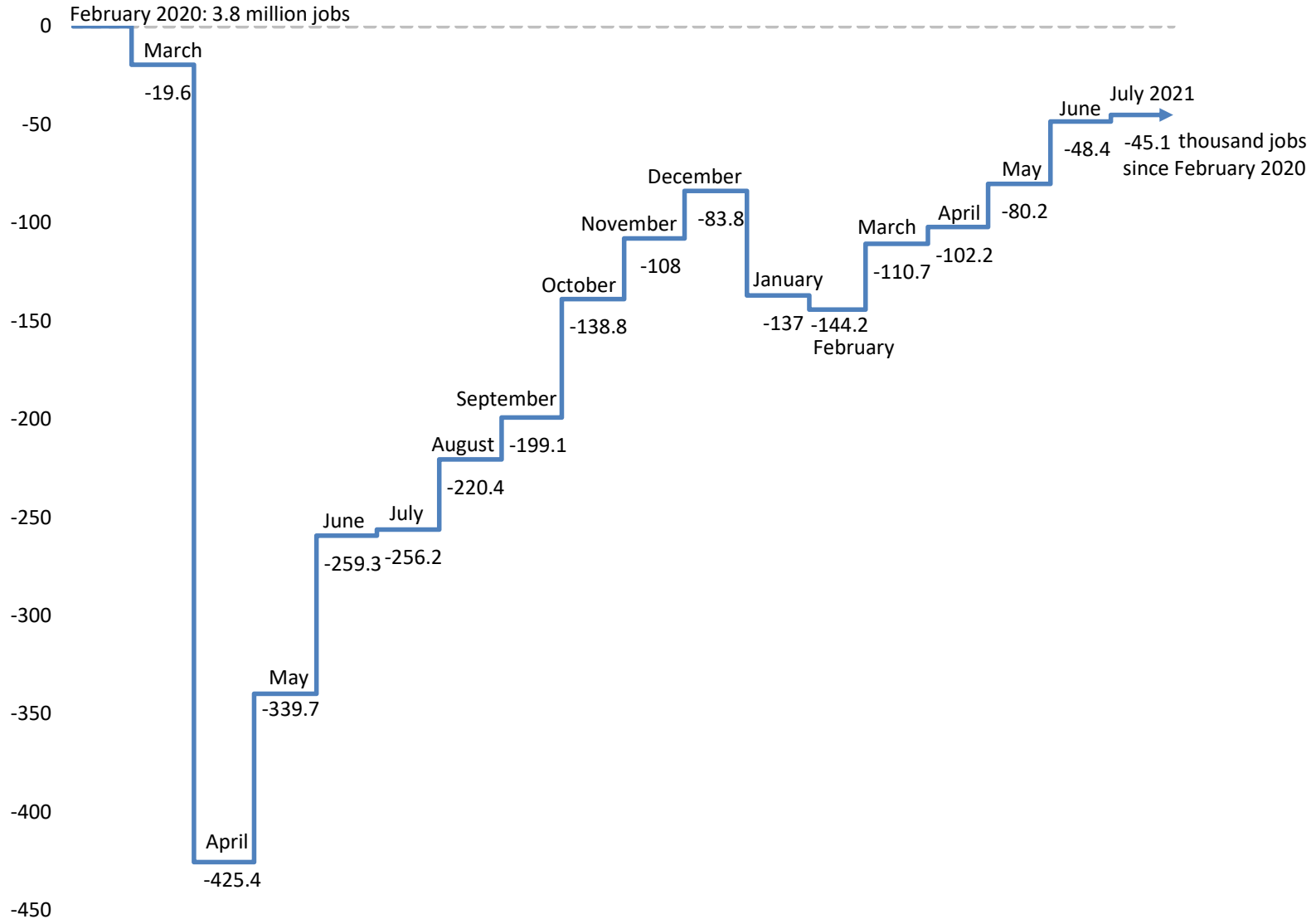
- The **leisure and hospitality (21%), other services (11%), and professional and business services (8%)** sectors have seen significant increases in employment in DFW.
- Nationwide, the **mining, quarrying, and oil and gas** and **transportation and utilities** sectors saw growth in employment by 7% each. Locally, these industries saw increases of 1% and 5%, respectively.
- **Job postings in the DFW area increased by 10,615, or roughly 30%.**

Cumulative change in jobs since February 2020 (thousands)



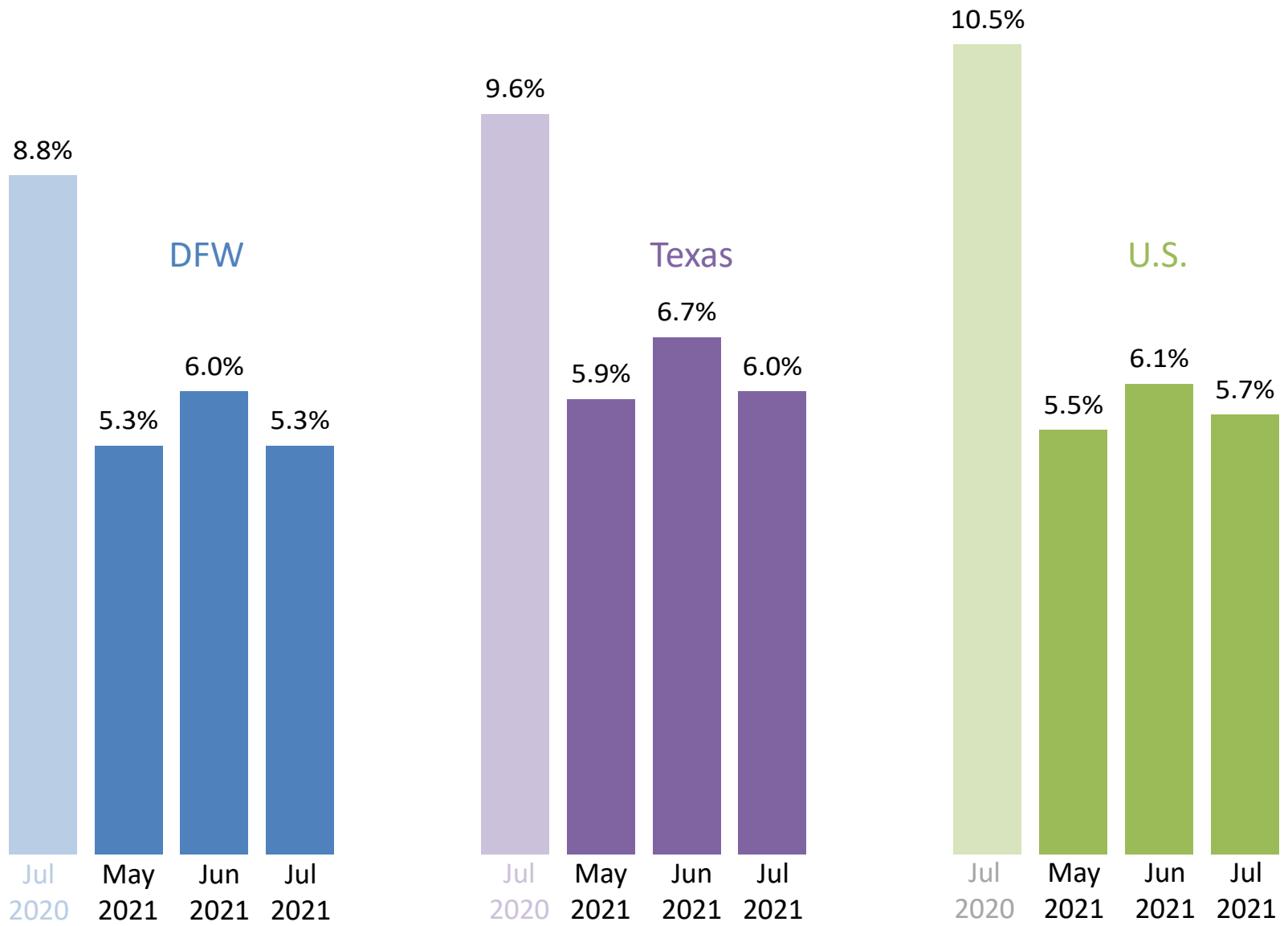

Unemployment Rates* in DFW, Texas, and U.S.



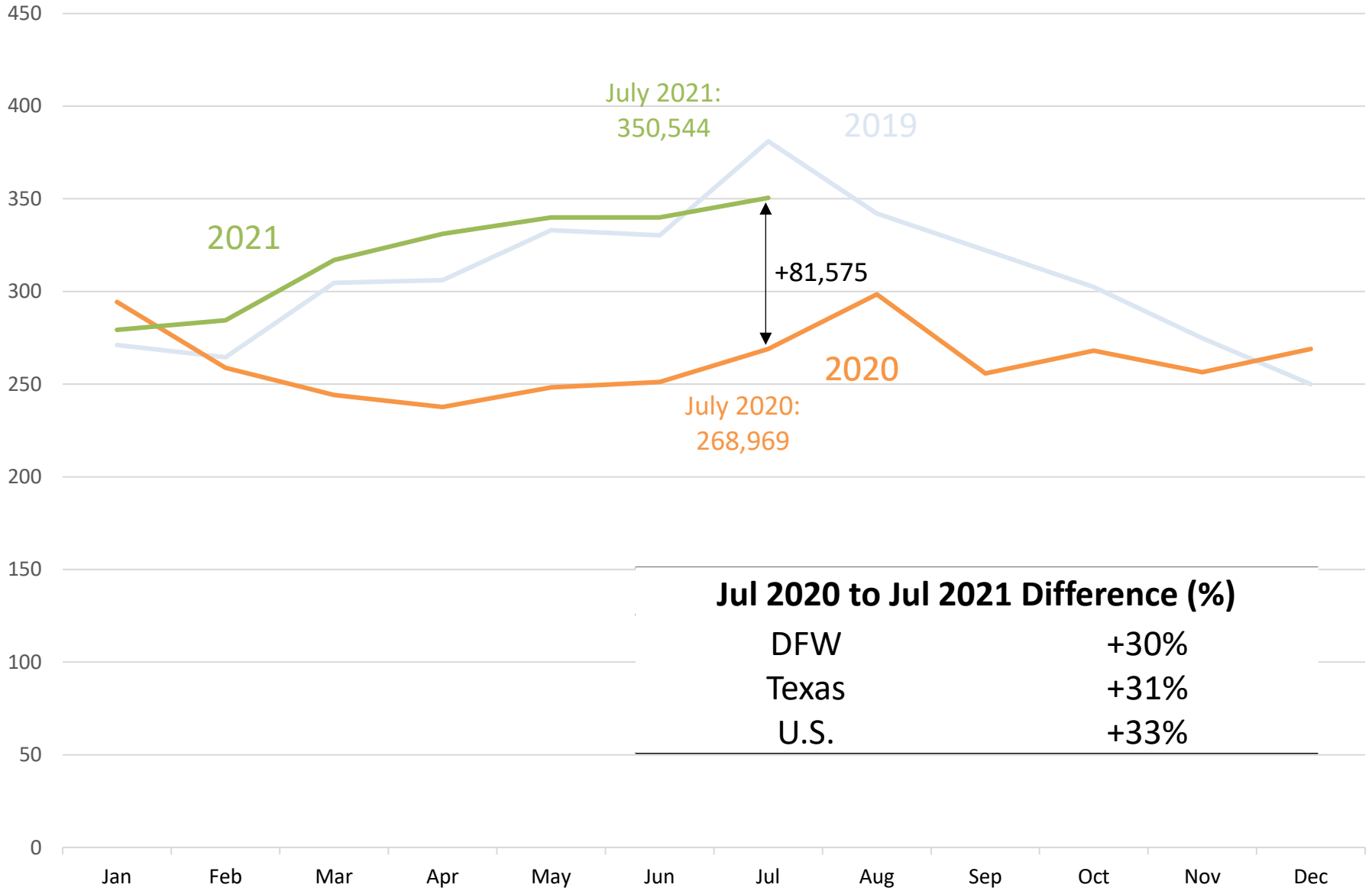
