*Skills Analysis for
UT Dallas Profiles - Part I:
Business Operations
and Financial Specialists
in DFW, 2021*

This report is for **Business Operations and Financial Specialists**, which encompasses one of the largest occupational groups for UT Dallas graduates. This is part of a larger series that will evaluate in-demand skills for job seekers in the DFW area.

When evaluating the UT Dallas profiles for these occupations, it is reassuring to see that **most of the top skills** listed in these profiles **match** with the postings for both **entry-level** and **all other jobs**. The implication is that students coming out of these programs are leaving with the skills necessary to succeed in the workforce.

Some of the top skills in the UT Dallas profiles more uncommon in the general labor market. For instance, **SQL** was one of the **top reported skills** in this group but was **not** in the top ten of the **general workforce**. Going off recent postings, this **skill is in high demand** and would be something of value for applicants with this knowledge to highlight.

Another important metric to monitor is the skills that saw the **largest percentage increases in demand**. Many of these, such as **R** and **Tableau**, compliment what is being seen with other software and programming skills like SQL and show a growing increase in interest as companies develop more tech-focused business models. Monitoring what might come next can give applicants an edge on their competition in the labor market.




Skill Volatility Over Last Five Months
