#### **Overview**

#### **U.S. Trade Trends**


Since 2020, the U.S. has seen a major jump in both exports and imports. Exports grew from \$1.43 trillion to \$2.06 trillion, while imports surged from \$2.33 trillion to \$3.27 trillion by 2024. Canada, Mexico, and China were the country's biggest export destinations in 2024, with trade values of \$349B, \$334B, and \$144B respectively — the only nations to exceed the \$100B mark in exports. These three also topped the list as leading import partners, but with Mexico rising to first place at \$506B, followed by China (\$439B) and Canada (\$413B). Unlike exports, imports above \$100B came from nine countries, showing broader sourcing. Despite strong trade activity, the U.S. ended the year with a trade deficit of \$1.2 trillion.

#### **Texas Trade Trends**


Texas mirrored national trends with sharp growth in trade. Exports increased from \$278B in 2020 to \$455B in 2024, and imports rose from \$248B to \$398B. Mexico remained Texas's top trade partner, leading both exports (\$124B) and imports (\$158B) in 2024. Canada and the Netherlands followed on the export side with \$37B and \$33B respectively, while imports came mainly from Canada (\$39B) and China (\$36B). Interestingly, although the Netherlands was a major export destination, its imports to Texas were relatively small — just \$2.3B. Unlike the nation, Texas closed the year with a positive trade balance of \$58 billion.








## **Top 10 Export Destinations of U.S (2024)**






## **Top 10 Export Commodities of US (2024)**






#### **Top 10 Export Destinations of Texas (2024)**






#### **Top 10 Export Commodities of Texas (2024)**






#### **U.S & Texas Imports from the World**








## Top 10 Import Countries - U.S (2024)






#### Top 10 Import Commodities – U.S (2024)






## **Top 10 Import Countries – Texas (2024)**
